## DECLARATION OF INTENTION

(Invalid for all purposes seven years after the date hereof)

I, Edward Thomas Johnson, aged 49 years,  
occupation farmer, do declare on oath that my personal  
description is: Color white, complexion light, height 5 feet 5 inches,  
weight 130 pounds, color of hair light brown, color of eyes brown  
other visible distinctive marks none

I was born in Portsmouth England  
on the 11th day of August, anno Domini 1864; I now reside  
at Elwood New Jersey  
(Give number, street, city or town, and State)

I emigrated to the United States of America from Liverpool England  
on the vessel Adriatic; my last  
(If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or name of transportation company should be given.)  
foreign residence was Portsmouth England

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign  
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to George V King  
of Great Britain and Ireland, of whom I am now a subject;
