Domini 1886; I now reside at Essex Harbor City - N. J.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Le Havre, France  
on the vessel La Savoie; my last  
foreign residence was Epernay - France  
(If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of occupation or name of transportation company should be given.)

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign  
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to The French  
Republic, of which I am now a <sup>citizen</sup> subject; I

arrived at the port of New York City, in the  
State New York on or about the 14th day  
of Feb, anno Domini 1911; I am not an anarchist; I am not a

polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith  
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
