DECLARATION OF INTENTION

(Invalid for all purposes seven years after the date hereof)

State of New Jersey ss: In the Common Pleas Court

I, Simon Gross, aged 35 years,

occupation grocer, do declare on oath that my personal
description is: Color white, complexion dark, height 5 feet 7 inches,
weight 180 pounds, color of hair brown, color of eyes brown
other visible distinctive marks none

I was born in Austria Hungary
on the 2nd day of March, anno Domini 1879. I now reside
at 36 N. Georgia Ave. Atlantic City, N. Jersey
(If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or name of transportation company should be given.)
I emigrated to the United States of America from Bremen Germany
on the vessel Prinzess Alice; my last
foreign residence was Austria Hungary

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign
prince, potentate, state or sovereignty, and particularly to Francis Joseph, Emperor
of Austria and Apostolic King of Hungary of whom I am now a subject;
I arrived at the port of Philadelphia, in the
State of Pennsylvania, on or about the 15th day
of April, anno Domini 1894; I am not an anarchist; I am not a
polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
