 weight 180 pounds, color of hair grey, color of eyes grey,
 other visible distinctive marks none.
 I was born in Lengfurt Germany
 on the 19th day of October, anno Domini 1867; I now reside
 at 2119 Boardwalk Atlantic City, N.J.

 I emigrated to the United States of America from Antwerp Belgium
 on the vessel Kronland; my last
(If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or name of transportation company should be given.)
 foreign residence was Lengfurt Germany.
 It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign
 prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to William and
German Emperor, of whom I am now a subject;

 of April, anno Domini 1902; I am not an anarchist; I am not a
 polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith
