 weight 152 pounds, color of hair brown, color of eyes brown
 other visible distinctive marks none
 I was born in Biersfeld b/Duren Germany
 on the 2nd day of September, anno Domini 1885; I now reside
 at 285 S. Congress Ave. Atlanta City ^{new} Georgia
(Give number, street, city or town and State.)
 I emigrated to the United States of America from Rotterdam Holland
 on the vessel Ryndam; my last
(If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or name of transportation company should be given.)
 foreign residence was Landstuhl Germany
 It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign
 prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to William 2nd
German Emperor, of whom I am now a subject;

 State of New York, on or about the 16th day
 of June, anno Domini 1914; I am not an anarchist; I am not a
 polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith
