I was born in Prenzlau Germany  
on the 17th day of September, anno Domini 1877 I now reside  
at 22 South Kentucky Ave Atlantic City N.J.  
(Give number, street, city, county, and State)

I emigrated to the United States of America from Hemerhorn Germany  
on the vessel Barbarossa; my last

foreign residence was Zoppot Germany; I am un married; the name  
of my wife is Hedwig Hantke she was born at Germany  
and now resides at 22 South Kentucky Ave Atlantic City N.J.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign  
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to German Empire

of whom I am now a subject;  
I arrived at the port of New York City in the  
State of New York on or about the 24th day  
of April, anno Domini 1913; I am not an anarchist; I am not a  
polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith  
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
