I was born in Strasbourg Germany
on the 9th day of August, anno Domini 1892; I now reside
at 319 North Massachusetts St. Atlantic City, N.J.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Southampton England
on the vessel S.S. America; my last
foreign residence was London England; I am — married; the name
of my wife is Milnea; she was born at Lwien
and now resides with me

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to The German
Empire, of whom I am now a subject;

polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
