

DECLARATION OF INTENTION.



UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

THE STATE OF OHIO,
Hamilton County.

Personally appeared before me, the undersigned, Clerk of the
COURT OF COMMON PLEAS within and for the County of Hamilton aforesaid

George Eckelkang
a native of *Hannover*
aged about *34* years, bearing allegiance to the
King of Hannover who emigrated from
Bremen on the *17th* day of
Sept. *1852*, and arrived at *New Orleans*
on the *20th* day of *October 1852*, and who
intends to reside within the jurisdiction and under the Government of
the United States, to-wit: *Cincinnati, O.*

And he makes report of himself for **Naturalization**, and declares on oath that
it is bona fide his intention to become a **CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**,
and to forever renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every Foreign Prince, Potentate,
State and Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly to the *King of Hannover*,
