# UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

## PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

of the Honorable the Common Pleas Court of Atlantic County N.J. hereby filed, respectfully sheweth:

The petition of Charles Koltz

First. My place of residence is Mizpah N.J. (Give number, street, city or town, and State.)

Second. My occupation is Laborer

Third. I was born on the 23 day of Jan'y, anno Domini 1875, at Stuttgart Germany

Fourth. I emigrated to the United States from Bremen Germany on or about the 27 day of April

anno Domini 1891, and arrived in the United States, at the port of New York City N.Y., on the 16 day of May

anno Domini 1891, on the vessel Elpis (If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or name of transportation company should be given.)

Fifth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 21st day of Oct, anno Domini 1909

at Mays Landing N.J. in the Com Pleas Court of Atlantic County

Sixth. I am not married. of no one and now reside at (Give number, street, city or town, and State.)

I have no children, and the names, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows:

Seventh. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to William II German Emperor of whom at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.

Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least, immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 16 day of May, anno Domini 1891, and in the State of New Jersey, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the 16 day of August, anno Domini 1891, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the County of Atlantic County N.J. and the same was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes to wit, and the cause of each has since been removed or removed.)

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition is my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Commerce together with my affidavit and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses thereto, required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
