I was born in Stamora, Germany,  
on the 11 day of January, anno Domini 1891; I now reside  
at Brighton Hotel, Atlantic City, N.J.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Bremen, Germany,  
on the vessel Kaiser Wilhelm; my last  
foreign residence was Stamora, Germany; I am married; the name  
of my wife is Peter Seffrin; she was born at Stamora, Germany,

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign  
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to The German  
Empire, of whom I am now a subject;

I arrived at the port of New York,  
State of N.Y., on or about the 4 day  
of October, anno Domini 1907; I am not an anarchist; I am not a  
polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith  
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
