OATH OF ALLEGIANCE

I hereby declare, on oath, that I absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to William II the German Emperor, an order of nobility, which of which I have heretofore been a citizen subject (and that I further renounce the title of I have heretofore held); that I will support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States of America against all enemies, foreign and domestic, and that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same.

ORDER OF COURT ADMITTING PETITIONER

Upon consideration of the petition of Frederick H. O. Huebner, and affidavits in support thereof, and further testimony taken in open Court, it is ordered that the said petitioner, who has taken the oath required by law, be, and hereby is, admitted to become a citizen of the United States of America, this 21 day of Sept, A. D. 1911.

(It is further ordered, upon consideration of the petition of the said Frederick H. O. Huebner, that his name be, and hereby is, changed to Frederick William O'Brien Huebner, under authority of the provisions of section 6 of an act entitled "An Act to establish a Bureau of Immigration and Naturalization, and to provide for a uniform rule for the naturalization of aliens throughout the United States," approved June 29, 1906.)
