Children, now in the Custody of said Marytie Gaurabronce.
To have and to hold, the said Wench and Children,
by these Presents bargained and sold, unto the said Marytie
Gaurabronce, her Heirs Executors, Administrators and Assigns
forever, And I the said Mindert Gaurabronce for myself,
my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, all the said Slaves
into the said Marytie Gaurabronce her Executors Admini-
strators and Assigns, against me the said Mindert Gaurabronce
my Executors Administrators and Assigns, and against
all and every other Person and Persons whatsoever shall
and will Warrant and forever defend by these Presents.
