PROPERTIES ALLOTTED TO AND PURCHASED BY THE BEHGEN REFORMED CHURCH ALSO SHOWING SALES AND LAND OWNED BY THE CHURCH AT PRESENT DATE.

FEBRUARY 10th 1914. compiled by Daniel Van Winkle.

January 30th 1658 Gov Stuyvesant Director General of new netherland obtained from the Indians a deed for all the lands in present Hudson County East of the Hudson River.

In consequence of previous Indian troubles, resulting in the massacre of many of the early settlers on the West bank of the Hudson, the authorities at New Amsterdam ordered that all settlers should remove to a concentrated village so that they could be the more easily protected.

Under this ordinance a Petition was granted for the founding of a village back of Communipaw and in 1660 the village of Bergen was laid out in the form of a square, the boundaries being still shown by the streets surrounding Bergen Square one block distant on each side. These streets mark the line of the Palisades which were erected for defence and protection The land outside of the town was known as Buytyn Town (outside gardens)

The lots inside the enclosure were soon taken up, while the outside lands were in Common plots of which were appropriated, some for Church purposes and others for farm or pasture lands by individuals and a plot early set aside for a Burying ground. Several Patents of land were issued by the Dutch authorities; these were guaranteed by the English on their accession.

Considerable friction was occasioned by encroachments upon the Common lands and January 14th 1714 a new Charter was granted, called Queen Anne's Charter.

This Act however did not remedy the difficulties and June 16th 1743 Articles of Agreement were entered into between the residents, Freeholders of Bergen, for the protection and care and division of the Common lands and confirming the ownership of the plots already taken up. But the difficulties were not determined until 1764 when by Act of Legislature

Commissioners were appointed, furveys made and Field book and Map filed showing Bounds, Limits and Location of patents granted, and general Partition of the Common lands.

Among the Allotments by these Commissioners were the following.

"We also found a small piece of land-lying Southeasterly from and near to the town of Bergen, which had been antiently either by the act or the general consent of the Freeholders set apart for the purpose of a burying ground".

"Beginning at a stake standing by a street, which stake is the easterly corner of an out-garden plot in Paulus Pieterse's Patent marked on the Map Number 103. and from said stake runs South 39 degrees west 2 chains and 2 links to a stake; then South 48 degrees East 1 chain and 44 links to a stake. Then North 48 degrees East 1 chain and 76 links to the scorner of said street. Then North 42 degrees West 1 chain 75 links along said street to the place of beginning."

This plot is located on the South side of present Vroom street at the junction of Tuers Ave. comprising the Northeasterly part of the present Burying ground on the East side of Bergen Ave. nearly opposite the Church.

It was on this plot Tradition says the first building used for Divine service was erected and for eighteen years used for that purpose.

/ Other Allotments Werefound as follows.

"We do set off, adjudgeaand allot to them, the said Minister and Elders ad and Deacons and their successors in office for ever, The sundry Tracts or Lots of land hereafter described being parcels of said Common Lands to be by them held and enjoyed for the use of said Church and Congregation."

"Our Survey of which sundry Tracts or Lots of land for said Church shows and we do adjudge them to be four Tracts or Lots."

"The First; being that whereon the Church now stands with the Burying"

yard adjoining to it (marked on the Map No.173.)"

Begins at a stake standing by the Northwest side of the road leading from the Town to Bergen Point (which stake is the easterly corner of an outgarden Plot in Tielman Van Vlecks Patent marked on the Map No. 129.) and from the said stake runs North 19 degrees and 40 minutes East 2 chains and 33 links to a stake standing at the Easterly corner of the Church Yard. Thence North 43 degrees and 15 minutes West 1 chain to a stake standing at the Northerly corner of the Church Yard. Thence South 40 degrees and 20 minutes West 2 Ch. and 74 links to a stake, thence South 63 degrees and ten minutes East 1 chain and 86 links to the place of beginning."

Avenue and Vroom Street, the spot on which the first octagonal church was built in 1680. This building stood until 1773 when a larger building was erected upon the same site, which in turn was torn down in 1841 and the present Church erected. The additional burying ground in the rear of above plot, was in later years purchased by Abraham Speer and by him opened up as a Cemètery.

THE SECOND PLOT being that whereon the Parsonage House now stands with the Garden, and a small piece of Pasture land adjoining thereto, (marked on the Map No. 174)

"Begins at a stake standing by the Northwest side of the road that leads from the Town to Bergen Point (which stake is the Southerly corner of an Out Garden plot in Tielman Van Vlecks Patent marked on the Map No.129) and from said stake runs South 14 degrees and 20 minutes West 6 chains and 75 linksalong said Road to a post (which post is the Easterly corner of the piece of land appropriated for Mechanics marked on the Map No. 171) And from said post runs North 67 degrees and 50 minutes West 3 chains and 12 links to a stake, thence South 26 degrees and 30 minutes West 6 chains and 15 links to a stake thence North 69 degrees and 15 minutes West 1 chain and ninety links

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to a stake, thence North 30 Degrees East 13 chains to a stake (standing at the westerly corner of the said Out Garden Plot in Tielmans Van Vlecks Patent marked on the Map No. 129) and from said stake runs South 63 degrees and ten minutes East 2 chains and 82 links to the place of beginning.

Bergen Reformed Church stands and extended from the rear line of the lots fronting on the Northerly side of Highland Ave. to and including Glenwood. The Parsonage alluded to above, was torn down in 1841 when the present Church building was erected. This property has all been sold with the exception of the plots on which the present Church and Parsonage stand and the plot in the rear, reaching from Highland to Glenwood Ave. now used as a Tennis Court.)

THE THIRD PLOT is a farm lot lying Southerly of the town of Bergen and back of Communipau (marked on the Map No. 175)""

"Beginning at a stake standing by a brook or creek (which stake is the Southerly corner of Fytje Hartmans second Patent marked on the Map No.15) and from said stake runs North 49 degrees and 20 minutes West 42 chains and 84 links to a stake. Thence South 35 degrees West 2 chains and 62 links to a stake. Thence North 50 degrees and 10 minutes West 6 chains and 77 links to a stake. Then South 43 degrees and 30 minutes West 13 chains and 80 links to a stake. Thence South 50 degrees East 25 chains and 34 links to a stake (being the Northerly corner of Dirck Classen's Patent marked on the Map No. 17) and from said stake runs South 27 degrees and 30 minutes East 23 chains and 86 links along said Dirck Classen's line to a stake by the edge of the meadow which is the Easterly corner of said Dirck Classen's Patent No. 17. Then North 27 degrees and 15 minutes East 11 chains and 4 links along the edge of the meadow to a stake standing by the Head of a small Creek. Thence South 46 degrees and 30 minutes East 2 chains and 75 links to where said small creek falls into Dirck Sycans Creek, Then up along said

Sycans Creek Northeasterly as it runs to the place of Beginning.

(This plot was located on the West side of present Bergen Ave. South of Oxford and sold by the Church in 1806, Sale confirmed Jan. 28th 1814.)

THE FOURTH PLOT is a lot of timbered land marked on the Map No. 176.

"Beginning at a stake (which stake stands North 36 degrees and 30 minutes East 94 chains and 50 links from large stone marked A 1764 planted at a corner of Wiehawken Commons) and from said stake runs North 52 degrees and 30 minutes West 38 chains to a stake. Thence North 36 degrees and 30 minutes East 3 chains and 95 links to a stake. Thence South 52 degrees and 30 minutes East 38 chains to a stake. Thence South 36 degrees and 30 minutes West 3 chains and 95 links to the place of Beginning.

(This plot was located at New Durham and sold May 9th 1838.)

In 1793 The Church purchased for a Parsonage for the Rev. John Cornelison the Cornelious Sip Homestead located on the North West corner of Bergen Square extending along the West side of Bergen Ave. and the Mortherly side of Academy Street. The Bergen Ave. frontage was sold to different parties in 1863-4, and later the Academy Street plot was sold to Charles Lewis. On this latter plot in 1852 a new Parsonage was built to which the Rev. Benjamin C Taylor removed from the old Sip Homestead.

The Southerly part of the present Burying ground was purchased by the Church in from the Tuers estate & became part of the Burying ground first described.
