For all that certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the Township of Covenanter Bergen State of New Jersey being a part of the farm on which the parties of the first part now reside between the Town of Jersey and Bergen in the County aforesaid on the South side of the Turnpike Road leading to Newark near a place commonly known by the Name of Priors Mill and near the East side of a road leading from the Turnpike aforesaid to the Town of Bergen commanding near a house called the Bulls Head the beginning place or corner of which said lot of land may be found in Manner following. That is to say when two straight lines would intersect each other if drawn. the first one from the North corner of a new factory now erecting by the said William Colgate party of the second part, North fifty degrees West One Chain Seventy One Links to the North corner of said lot. the other line to be drawn from the West corner of said factory North ten degrees Forty five Minutes West two chains fifty seven links to the North corner of the lot aforesaid where a stake now stands or said lines would intersect each other from which place of intersection or stake South Seventy degrees East three chains three links thence South twenty degrees Fifteen Minutes West by chain forty links thence North Seventy

degrees west three chains three links three
North twenty degrees fifteen minutes east six
chains forty links to the place of Beginning
Containing 2 acres more or less.
