

Egg Harbor School Again Wins Banner.

Local Pupils do Well at County Arithmetic & Spelling Contests Held at May's Landing Saturday.

For the second consecutive time our pupils took first rank in the arithmetic contest of Atlantic County schools held at May's Landing last Saturday. It was a clean cut victory. Our team average was 95 per cent. with Hammonton second, 88 per cent. 95 per cent. was the winning average last time the banner came to Egg Harbor.

The team was represented by the following pupils with their averages: James Cope 100, Ralph Merkord 100, Eleanor Daley 100, Henrietta Hofmann $87\frac{1}{2}$ and Paul Mue-ther $87\frac{1}{2}$. In the first contest 10 perfect papers were handed in, hence a second contest had to be taken, since only eight prizes were offered and in that contest James Cope took third prize and Ralph Merkord fourth.

In the spelling contest our pupils

stood fourth in team average. Ventnor City again won the banner with 93 per cent. Our average was 86. The following pupils represented our team: Eleanor Daley 89, Karl Frisbie 89, Genevieve Michel 87, Ralph Merkord 82 and Clara Hall 81.

The Eighth Grade pupils sang and Clarence Morgenweck spoke "American's Creed" at the afternoon program. It is needless to say, that the pupils enjoyed themselves immensely.

If the school is able to win the arithmetic banner next year it will remain permanently the property of our school. Our people have reason to be proud of the showing that our school made in competition with the schools of the county.
