




BERGEN REFORMED CHURCH

HISTORICAL NOTES.

The Reformed Dutch Church of Bergen is the oldest religious organization within the territory now constituting the State of New Jersey.

Between the months of August and October in the year 1660, a group of immigrants under charter from Governor Peter Stuyvesant, founded on the four blocks surrounding the open space now known as Bergen Square, the Village of Bergen. A school master was immediately appointed, and while teaching a few children of the pioneers during the week, he gathered the older ones on the Sabbath Day to worship God and listen to a sermon from a printed book. The school teacher became known as the Voorleser.

A building for the double purpose of church and school was erected within a few years; and finally the school house was built on the lot, corner of Bergen Square and Academy Street, which is still a part of the site on which stands a magnificent school house, known as No. 11.

In 1680, an octagonal church was erected on the corner of Vroom Street and Bergen Avenue. A larger church, after the model of the churches in the old country, was erected in 1773, and the present edifice, the third stone church in which the congregation has worshiped, was dedicated in 1842. The Parish House in the rear of the present church was added in 1882.

For nearly ninety years the church was under the care of a succession of Voorlesers, and the sacraments were administered by ministers from the Church of New York. They were brought over from Manhattan Island to Communipaw and driven to Bergen over the first road built in the county, which followed the line of Summit Avenue.

Pete De Wint was installed as Pastor of the church in the year 1750, but there were irregularities concerning his ordination which finally lead to his withdrawal.

Three years later a call was made on a young theological student, William Jackson. The conditions of the call were, that he should cross the ocean, attend the University of Utrecht and finally be ordained by the classes of Amsterdam in the Netherlands. On his return he became pastor of the combined churches of Bergen and Staten Island. A stone parsonage was built for him on the site of the porch of the present church.

The Glebe, surrounding the parsonage, at that time consisted of a plot of four acres. Dominie Jackson remained in active service until 1790, when failing health compelled his resignation. The church secured to him the possession of the parsonage during his life and he remained among the people of his charge for thirty years.

The Rev. John Cornelison was ordained as Pastor on the 26th day of May, 1793, and remained in charge of the church until his death on the 26th of March, 1828.

Two months after the loss of their old Pastor, the Rev. Benjamin C. Taylor was installed. Dr. Taylor's active service extended over a term of forty-four years, and for ten years longer he survived as Pastor Emeritus.

In 1871, the Rev. James L. Amerman became Pastor and after a service of five years, resigned to enter upon the new work of the Church of Christ in Japan.

In August, 1876, the Rev. Cornelius Brett was called from the church of Montgomery, N. Y., and still remains at his post. The Rev. William V. D. Strong acted as Assistant Pastor for two years and a half, and the Rev. John J. Moment was Associate Pastor for three years. With October of 1911, the Rev. Abram Duryee began his service as Assistant Pastor. With the collaboration of Dr. Brett and Mr. Duryee, the Reformed Church of Bergen is continuing, amid the perplexing problems of modern life, the service to this community of the historic Church.

REPORT OF BERGEN CHURCH TO THE SOUTH CLASSIS OF BERGEN.

The Consistory of the Bergen Reformed Church has been engaged during the whole year in a thorough revisal of the roll of members.

The days of permanent old families has ceased, and changes from year to year in the habitations of the congregation make it exceedingly difficult to give pastoral care.

Many, in removal from the city, fail to take their letters and after long forbearance it becomes necessary to transfer their names to the absentee list. It is painful to record that the number of those who seem to have been lost to the church, by an absence of several years, has reached the aggregate of 62.

We have further made an effort by correspondence, to persuade absentees whose addresses were known, to ask for letters of dismissal. Eighteen of these have been dismissed. With the further loss of seven beloved members, who have joined the Universal Church in the Land Beyond, our total loss for the year is 88 members, reducing our census for the first time in many years to 661.

With all these discouragements, we rejoice in the fidelity of those who remain to continue the traditions of our ancient heritage.

In the beginning of Autumn the Consistory invited the Rev. Abram Duryee, of North Hackensack, N. J., to be Assistant Pastor. He began his service on the first of October and we have found him a true yoke fellow, zealous for the Kingdom of God. In the distribution of labor, while he is engaged in every department of Church work, his specialty is the Educational and Young Peoples' work. The Sunday School has been reorganized as a graded school, the room of the Primary Department has been altered to accommodate an up to date class.

The Young Peoples' Society of Christian Endeavor has been revived. All the Societies, including a Men's Club of more than 200 members, are active in their several departments of service.

At every Communion there have been additions to the membership, and in March we received 25 on confession of faith, nearly all graduates of the Pastor's Class, four by letter. The total accessions for the year are 42. A small advance has been made in benevolence.

We sadly record the death of another beloved, useful Elder, Elijah Strong Cowles, whose departure was a great loss to the congregation.
