Shepherd Lake

This 541-arer tract, in the heart of the Ramapo Mountains, was acquired by the State of New Jersey in 1966 for park purposes. It is located in Passis: Country along the New Jersey-New York boundary, about 14 miles north of Pompton Lakes, New Jersey and 3 miles south of Sloatsbury. Vork: The attractiveness of the area is enhanced by a 74-acre springfed mountain lake and woodland terrain with elevations from 500 to 1,040 feet aboye sea level.

The park has been dedicated as a wildlife sanctuary. Hunt-ing, trapping and the carrying of firearms or bows and arrows are prohibited.

Boating and Fishing

Bosting and Fining
Shipherd Lake offers exciting opportunities to the fisherman. Rainbow, brown and tiger troot, pickerel, northern
pike and catish may be taken subject to the New Jersey
fishing laws. Rowboats are rented at the boarbouse for fishing
and other boating enjoyment. Private craft (small boats without motors) may be launched for a nominal fee. Bait is on
side at the boat dock.

Facilities, in attractive settings along the shore of Shepherd Lake and in adjacent wooded areas, are provided for family and group picnies. Nearby are parking areas, refreshment concession, playfield for games and playground equipment for children.

Picnic fires are permitted but must be confined to the metal stoves and fireplaces provided, or to stoves brought by the picnicker subject to approval by a park officer.

Charcoal may be purchased at the park.

Hiking

Hiking is popular on many roads and trails in the park and visitors may explore the interior woodland and experience the excellent views from high elevations.

Open all year the 3 trap fields and 4 skeet fields are available for night shooting Tuesday through Friday and-day shooting Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.




