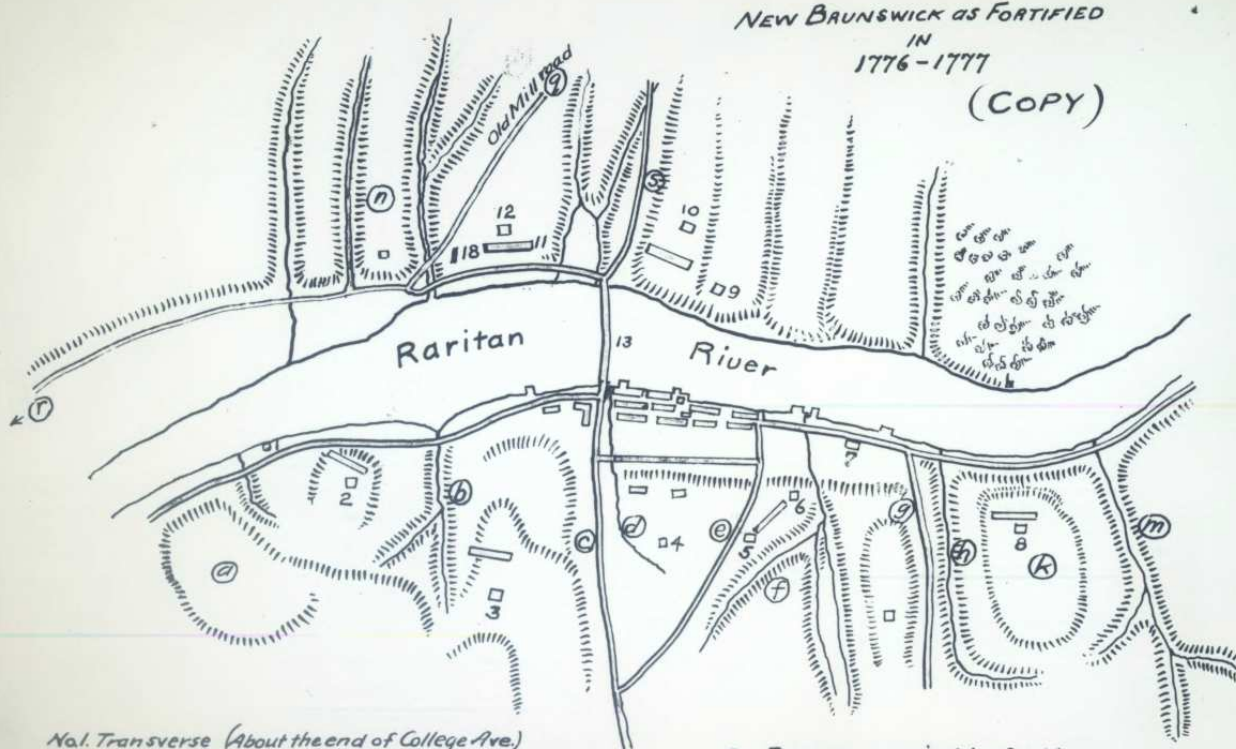


NEW BRUNSWICK AS FORTIFIED

4. Flesh-- Hessian Post of the same Batt. (About Court Ho.)
5. Entrenched House-- a post of Ds (The Vail--Guest Ho. rear)
6. Work to cover the left of the Town, occupied by 26th Regt.
7. Ds. (Near site of old Presby'n ch.)
8. Redoubt occupied by Col. Koyler's Batt. Hess. Grenads.
9. Flesh occupied by 28th Regt.
10. Redoubt by Ds.
11. Flesh occupied by Guards.
12. Redoubt by 35th Regt.
13. A Log Bridge built by the Army 1777.
