SECTION 6. RESIDENCE DISTRICTS — (b) FRONTAGE AND AREA OF LOTS — Within any Residence A District each lot or not less than one hundred fifty (150°) feet in width and an area of not less than twenty-two thousand five hundred (22,500) square feet and an average depth of not less than one hundred fifty (150°) feet measured at right angles to the street line.

Residence District shall occupy an area greater than twenty per cent (20%) of the area of the lot upon which it is built."
SECTION 4. That the provisions of any ordinance or part thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby expressly repealed.
