#### PRESIDENT McKINLEY AT THE EXPOSITION.

Our cameras were at work at the Pan-American Exposition during President McKinley's entire visit, and we recorded many scenes incidental to the coming and going of the Presidential party. We were also fortunate enough to have our camera in position to take pictures of the assassin's attempt to shoot the President, on Thursday, September 5th, 1901, and thus secured a picture of our Executive while making his last appearance before the crowd, just moments before the fatal shot. September 6th, 1901, we also had our camera in position to photograph the President as he left the Temple of Music, but the assassin's assassination, of course, prevented taking this picture. We did, however, secure an excellent panoramic view of the mob surging in front of the Temple of Music attempting to get at the assassin. These pictures are the best and most interesting. In addition to being the best and easiest recognized views of the President and Mrs. McKinley, they depict the best acts of our beloved ruler before he was shot. Our cameras were also in full work at the Pan-American Exposition on the day of President McKinley's speech, Thursday, September 5th, and on Friday, September 6th, the day of the shooting. #### JEFFRIES-RUHLIN SPARRING CONTEST.

On the night of November 15, 1901, James J. Jeffries, of Los Angeles, California, and Gus Ruhrin, of Akron, Ohio, engaged in a sparring contest in the ring of the Twentieth Century Athletic Club, at Michigan's Dreamland. Frank Clegg, the arranger of the bout with the promoters of the contest, Messrs. J. C. Kramely, Wm. Madden and Wm. Delano, cameras were on hand, and we secured many pictures of the combat. In order to record the pictures, it was necessary to specially equip the building with a huge number of arc lights. To this end an expert was engaged, and when the fighters entered the ring it was like daybreak in the center of a mass of light. Thus we are able to present to our customers, not imitation or fake pictures of the contest, but the actual situation just as it took place, with all the audience in view. The fighters were so intent upon every movement in the contest, from the time they entered the ring until the bell left a dotor, in the fifth round. We give herewith an account of the fight, and also the record of the bout. When Jeffries came through the throng and clashed into the ring there was great cheering. Ruhrin advanced into the ring and was prostrate on his feet.

Immediately he had left the ring the fighters shook hands and "went at it."
