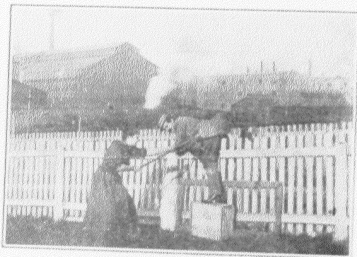
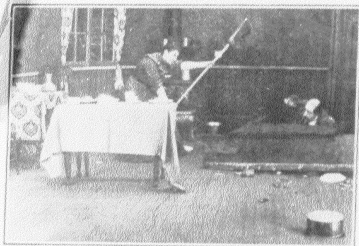


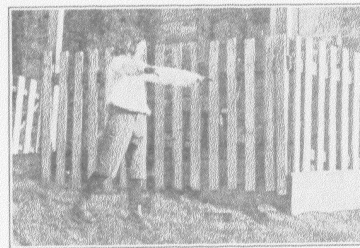
Where's That Quarter?
