

### **OUR TEMPLE BUILDING**

#### THE SEVEN-YEAR STORY

After World War II a steady influx of people into our community, accompanied by a resurgence in social consciousness and religious affiliation, brought to Temple Sholom a steadily-increasing problem of space. To meet these demands, the frame house adjacent to the Temple was purchased in 1951 and five classrooms created. The building was also used for overflow services on the High Holy Days. The acquisition of this site was essential to the construction of our new building.

The ingenuity of the Trustees was taxed again and again as the problem deepened. "Split-session" Sunday School, seats in the aisles, services in the Paramount Theater, all were tried. It was evident that there was only one solution; we had outgrown our home.

In June, 1954, Daniel Eisenberg and Herman Seiden were appointed by President Nathan K. Feldman to a special committee to study an expansion program. Together with the president and vice-president William Schuldenfrei, they consulted the building bureau of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations and qualified architects. They talked with each Trustee to get personal reactions and to assure support. On the committee recommendation, the Board of Trustees unanimously approved a program of expansion to include a new sanctuary, social hall and sufficient classroom space. In May, 1955, the congregation, at its annual meeting, enthusiastically ratified this action.

A contract for architectural services was signed with Mr. George Levy of Elizabeth on November 28th, 1955, and a long series of conferences and consultations followed. Progress was slow because we wanted the best possible building within our resources. After many revisions, the plans were completed and six qualified building contractors submitted bids for construction. The contract was awarded to Branciforte Builders, Inc., and signed on January 7, 1960. No time was wasted in getting started. Groundbreaking ceremonies were held in the Temple on Sunday, February 14th. Our Mens' Club, Sisterhood and Youth Group all participated and pledged their support.

As the building progressed, problems were encountered that had to be met without delay. The members of the building committee cooperated to the utmost. The congregation of Temple Sholom and the members of the future owe a debt of gratitude to the men of this committee. Summer and winter, Saturday afternoons, Sunday mornings, week-day nights, on very short notice, meetings were called and all attended.

The building committee was first named by Mr. Feldman in 1954, and with very little exception has remained intact through these seven years, having been reappointed by presidents Schuldenfrei and Darwin. The members are: Milton Brown, Irwin Borsuk, William Goldstein, Robert Reis, William Schuldenfrei, Herbert M. Schwartz, Harold Schwartz and Milton Simkin, co-chairman.

On this occasion of the dedication of our beautiful Temple, the problems and anxieties of the past are forgotten in the pride we feel as final completion nears. There is much to be done, - furnishings and seats, art work and embellishments, air-conditioning and landscaping, all are on the horizon. With the help and cooperation of each member, all these will be done in time and our building become truly a majestic House of God in which each of us may long enjoy a deep reverence and inspiring religious experience.




