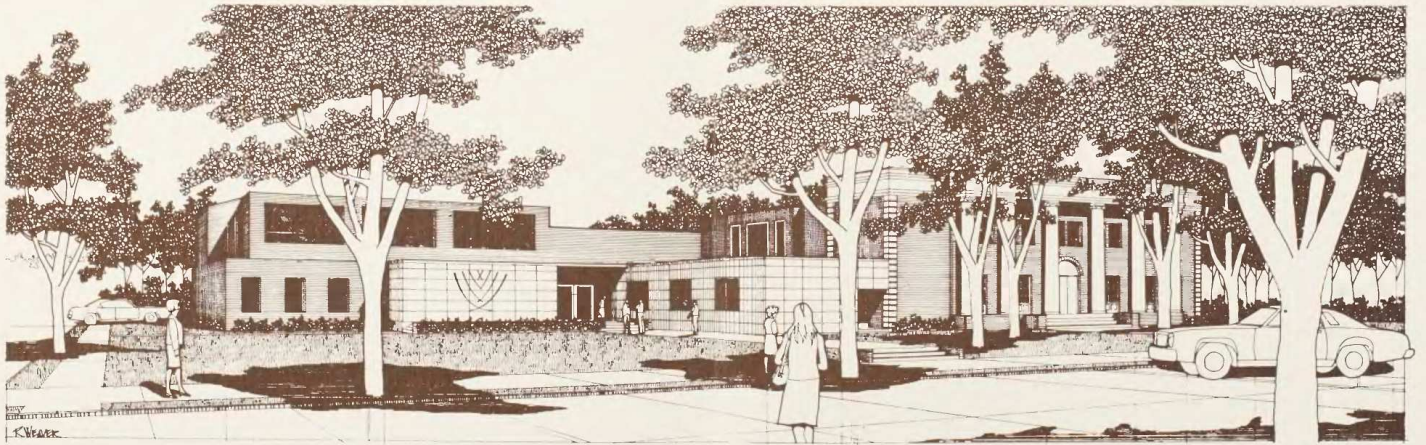

Jewish tradition provides the opportunity to honor those we love, and to create a Living Memorial for those who are no longer with us.

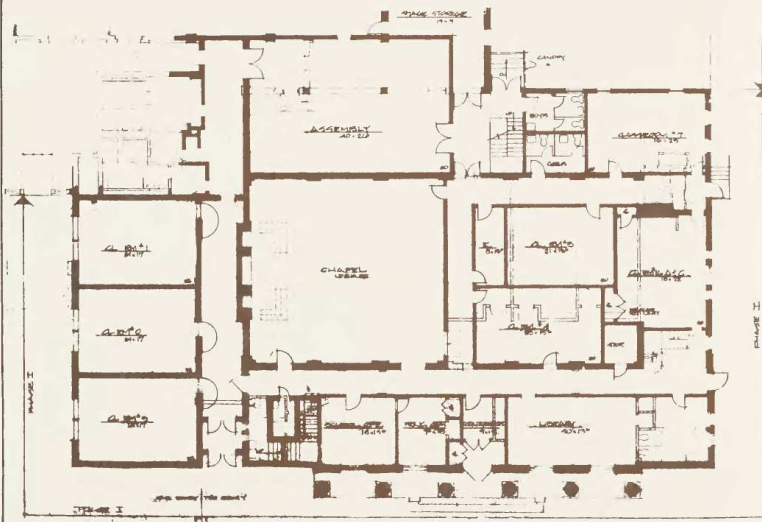

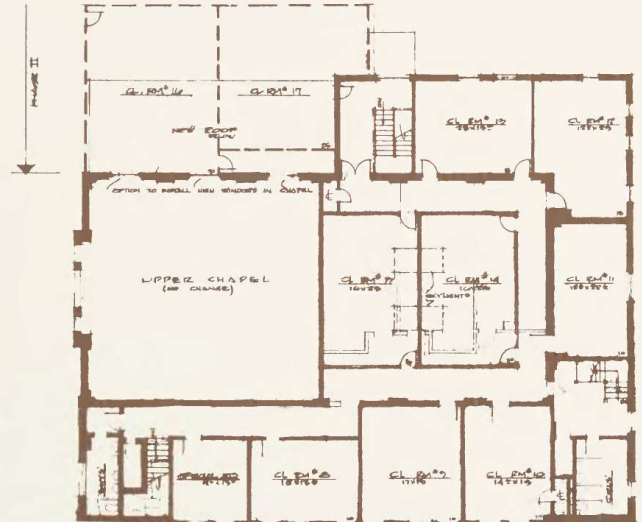
The value placed on the various units bears no relation to their cost of construction or purchase, but rather relates to their desirability as Tribute or Memorial units.
