Be it Remembered that on the....Sixth.....day of....October.....in the year of our Lord one thousand...nine...hundred and....five.....personally appeared in open Court,.....FRANK MONTESANO.....an Alien, a native ofITALY.....and prayed to be admitted to become a Citizen of the United States; and it appearing to the said Court that he has resided in the United States three years next preceding his arrival at the age of twenty-one years, and has continued to reside therein until this time, and he having at this time under oath, in open Court, made the declaration required in the first condition of the first section of the Act of Congress entitled "An act to establish an uniform rule of Naturalization, and to repeal the Acts heretofore passed on that subject." And the said applicant having declared on Oath, and proved to the satisfaction of the Court, that for the three years next preceding this time it has been BONA FIDE his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and that he has now arrived at the age of twenty-one years and upwards. And the Court being satisfied that he has resided in the United States five years at least, and within the State of New Jersey one year at least; and that during that time he has behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same. And, he having all this time declared on Oath, in open Court, that he will support the Constitution of the United States, and that he does absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty, whatever, and particularly, to Victor...Emmanuel...III.,...King of...Italy whom he was heretofore a subject or citizen.

This Court do thereupon, by virtue of the acts of the Congress of the United States in such case made and provided, admit him to all the rights, privileges and immunities of a FREE CITIZEN of the United States of America.
