Was Confined in Hospital at Davis Island Was Wounded Sept 17. 1862

Was Taken Prisoner June 22<sup>nd</sup> 1864 front of Petersburg Va

Was Paroled February 27. 1865

The first Battle Engaged in was Bone Run 2<sup>nd</sup> Mobile Bay Fort Fisher.

Some of my Intimate Comrades were James Fisher Abe Percum Jesse Hawks  
 Wicoff Woodhewer William Peyton John Strubble.

The most important event of Service was at Mobile Bay.



 Bristow Station Fredericksburg Chancellorville Gettysburg Pa Wapping Heights  
 Mc Cleans Ford Mine Run Wilderness Spottsylvania Court House North Anna River  
 Petersburg

Some of my most Valuable Comrades Chaplain J D. Rose Captain James Brown  
 Frank Pollard H. G. Emmell Eugene Pollard William Tell John & Abel Gruber  
 Charles Corblier J Searing & Tompkins &

I deem the most important events at Chancellorsville I left the Rank & Rugged forward  
 Hood and I in hands said come on Boys we captured 7 stand of Colouers  
 & while on the seven days march was stricken with Typhoid Fever and had to be  
 carried to Hospital at the white House from there was sent North to Die But  
 Good care from my sister was soon able to join my Regiment
