1st—By the Churches?..... Baptist Mission for Italians.

2nd—By the Schools?..... The Board of Education maintains Americanization Classes in which the men and women who are applying for Naturalization are instructed.

3rd—By Social Settlements?— Jewish Community Centre -
Lectures - social groups.

4th—By Clubs, Y. M. C. A., Y. W. C. A., etc?

..... We have no Y. W. C. A. in the City. The Y. M. C. A. is not engaged in any special Americanization work.

How many Classes in English are maintained?

Is there any plan for teaching English to the women in their homes or in small neighborhood groups? Not to my knowledge.

Is any suitable recreation provided for this class of women; if so, state what form?

Any substitute for the saloon provided for the men; if so, what is it?

..... There seems to have been a strengthening of clubs already organized. There has been no organized effort to provide a saloon substitute.

Is there an employment bureau or any means of providing work for those who need it?

..... Yes, at the City Hall; same is under direction
of Mr. James P. Laverty.

Is there proper supervision of mid-wives? Yes

Proper birth registration? Yes, through Board of Health.

Pre-natal clinics? No

Baby clinics? Yes, under city administration.

A system of follow-up work for mothers and babies?

..... Yes, by Baby clinic; and the Tuberculosis clinic.

Are there enough Public Schools to accommodate the children comfortably and with proper ventilation and safety from fire? Yes

Are there special classes for children undeveloped physically?

..... Not a sufficient number to warrant the establishment of
such classes.

Classes for the mentally sub-normal? Yes in Public School No. 3.

How many? 7 classes under supervision

Proper supervision of all children to prevent contagious diseases?
..... Yes through a Medical Inspection Department

How many public playgrounds are there? Eight

What proportion of the children are in parochial schools? Approximately 1/6

Is English taught in these schools? Yes

Is there any effort to teach English to the foreign children by means of story-telling, games, etc?
..... Not at this date.
