August 1, 1943

3:05 P.M.

Right now when the sun is on my eyes
I'm in the field for 10 days, this is the
6th. The reason for all the smudges you
will find on my paper is that I have
billed since Friday and when plenty dirty.

The only reason I have time to answer
now is that I'm operating a field telephone
(oops that's my ring) and was only another operator
telling me, and be here all night with the
expectation of 4 hrs to wash my self and my
clothes. some fun, eh!

There's no beauty here. I
say I like the U.S.O.'s Frydholm is
fully good one. I can't say about m.k.'s
U.S.O.

I can't say as I ever heard of
an Allan Rappenberg, but if he's from
Rutgers he's O.K.

This 10 days is not at all tough in fact
its sort of fun. Today we're eating
regular food ration. They eat but
we get candy, cigarettes, lemonade, coffee,
some cheese, & cookies in them

In morning I had, cigarettes, coffee,
ham & eggs, cookies, & 3 lumps of sugar,

at dinner I had cigarettes, lemonade

cheese, cookies, candy, and 2 lumps of sugar.
