

Statement by Chairman:

The applicant upon arrival was certified for trachoma, a dangerous, contagious disease, and accordingly rejected. He applied for hospital treatment which was granted by the Secretary of Labor. Medical certificate, dated today, certifies him free from disease. Consequently, he is admissible under the general immigration act.

He is the rightful holder of a section six certificate and is therefore admissible upon identification under the Chinese exclusion act, and I move that he be landed.

Inspector Stewart: I second the motion.

Inspector Keagy: I vote to make the motion unanimous.

Q. Do you wish a certificate of identity? A. Yes.
