Investigation by Health Officer Cole at the subject's laundry at 377 - 15th Avenue, Newark, disclosed that he was absent in New York City and was not expected to return for several days. At the Eye & Ear Infirmary the records did not show when the subject had been told to return for treatment. I arranged with the infirmary authorities and with Health Officer Cole to inform this office as to when the subject would return for treatments. Mr. Cole informed this office by phone that the subject would be at the infirmary on Tuesday, July 21st, between 12:30 and 1:00 P.M.

On July 15th I filed a complaint against the subject before United States Commissioner Holland at Newark, N.J. Warrant was immediately handed to the United States Marshal, with instructions that the Chinese be taken into custody on July 21st at the time and place aforementioned. No Assistant United States Attorney was available but Commissioner Holland stated that he would arrange to have this office notified if the Chinese is taken into custody, as planned.
