The heavy red lines indicate improved roads built under the provisions of the New Jersey act of 1892, with some of the connecting roads, built by the local authorities, without State aid. The dotted lines indicate turnpikes.

Note for want of space many other roads built in Essex, Passaic and Union Counties, and many miles of light gravel roads along the Atlantic coast are not indicated.
