RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Money can be withdrawn only upon presentation and surrender of this card at Whittier House. One week's notice of intention to withdraw money may be required.
2. Deposits *must* be made by attaching stamps to this card, and are received in no other way. Stamps must be attached to the card by the local treasurer. When one card is filled, ask for another.
3. No sum can be withdrawn less than the amount represented by all the stamps attached. **If this card is lost or destroyed, no payment will be made thereon.** Stamps will be redeemed **only** when attached to a stamp card.
4. Five cents will be charged for all cards on which the amount withdrawn is less than fifty cents.
5. This card is not transferable.
6. The Fund is not a savings bank, but only an agency whereby small savings may be readily deposited. It is only responsible for the deposit of all moneys received by it in some Trust Company, Savings Bank or other institution duly authorized by law to receive trust funds; it is not responsible for any default of such depository.
7. Every deposit is made and accepted subject to the above rules and conditions.
