of things therunto belonging. And I do strictly charge and require all Non Commissioned Officers and Soldiers under his command to
be obedient to his orders as 5th Corporal. And he is to observe and follow such orders and directions from time to time, as he
shall receive from me or the future Commanding Officer of the Regiment, or other Superior Officers and Non Commissioned Officers set
over him, according to the rules and discipline of War. This Warrant to continue in force during the pleasure of the Commanding Off-
icer of the Regiment for the time being.
