6		Stephanie	The little one doesn't write that big, so I'll have more room.  Reading the problem: Stephanie. Wait Stephen. Stephan has a white shirt, a blue shirt, and a yellow shirt. Want me to read it out loud?
7		Dana	No I'll do it. He has a pair of blue jeans and a pair of white

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		jeans. How many different outfits can he make?
8	Stephanie	Well why don't we draw a picture?
9	Dana	Okay. He had a white shirt.
10	Stephanie	So I'll make white shirt.
11	Dana	A blue shirt.
12	Stephanie	Think I'll have to use this big marker for this one. You know to color it all in.
13	Dana	And a yellow shirt.
14	Stephanie	Why don't we just draw a "y" a "b" and a "w".
15	Dana	That's what I'm doing.
16	Stephanie	"w" "b" and "y". Okay let me read this, he has a blue jeans and a pair of white jeans. Okay, so I'm going to make a blue, blue. <i>Inaudible</i> Okay so lets find out how many different outfits you can make. You can make white and white. That would be one.

21	Dana	I know we have that, so we have two cause you could put the blue with the white

27	Dana	One two three four five, I have six so far.
28	Stephanie	I've got one, two, three, four, five. What are your other combinations? I have white and blue, I got white and white, I've got blue and white, I've got yellow and white. What were your two other combinations?
29	Dana	I mean I have six.
30	Stephanie	So what were your two other combinations?
31	Dana	You mean one other combination.
32	Stephanie	I only have four.
33	Dana	The yellow and the blue
34	Stephanie	Yellow and the blueand what was your other
35	Dana	Yellow and the white.
36	Stephanie	I put the yellow and the white.
37	Dana	Okay, then the blue and the white.
38	Stephanie	Five, six. Oh, okay so now I have six.
39	Dana	Amy we're done.
40	R1	You're done?
41	Stephanie	No Dana we don't know if we can make any more

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		combinations or not.

43	R1	Make sure okay? Talk about it and make sure.

45	Stephanie	Okay, you're right it's six.
46	Dana	Amy we're done. The answers six
47	Stephanie	It's six.
48	R1	Are you both convinced of that?

50	R1	Can you explain it to me?
51	Stephanie	Well okay. If we have three shirts and two pants, we just drew

57	R1	So six? What are these lines you drew, you drew lines between the shirts and the pants.
58	Stephanie	So we could make sure that we were, that we did not do that again and say seven, eight, nine, ten. We drew lines so that we could count our lines and say oh we can't do that again,

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		we can't do that again.
