NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed change of name be submitted to the voters at the general election to be held in the Borough of Riverside in the month of November, 1930.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Clerk advertise that said change of name will be voted upon at such election in the same manner as municipal elections are advertised.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk of the County of Bergen be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to have printed upon the ballots to be voted upon within the Borough of Riverside at the next general election, the following public question to be voted upon, to wit:

> "SHALL the name of the Borough of Riverside, Bergen County, New Jersey, be changed from 'Borough of Riverside' to 'Borough of River Edge?' "
