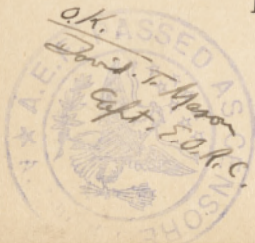

Nov. 18, 1917.

My dear Mr. Silvers:

Your letter of Oct. 22 is received and I'm delighted to hear of your plans for letting the men in the army hear how things are going at home. I'm sure will be glad to have all the news you're able to send, for it's one of the scarest things over here.

Have been over here for a month and a half now, and find France most interesting. One of the most striking things is the really wonderful road system. Have traveled several hundred miles by motor in different parts of the country, and every where find the same splendid roads.

Dear Captain Mason:

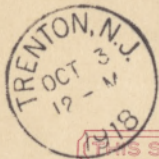
Thank you for your brief note
