DELETION OF HARBOR LINES
IN THE DELAWARE RIVER, SCHUYLKILL RIVER
AND CHRISTINA RIVER

Reference is made to Corps of Engineers Public Notice
CEA9-67-28-Harbor Lines dated March 16, 1960 soliciting public
comment regarding the proposed deletion of Marboir Island, Pinhead
Lines and Pine Island Lines; previously established in the Delaware,
Schuylkill and Christina Rivers. These Harbor Lines are located in
the Delaware River from Marboir Hook, Pennsylvania to Morrisville,
Pennsylvania and from National Park, New Jersey to Trenton, New
Jersey; in the Schuylkill River from the mouth to Spring Garden
Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; and in the Christina River from
the mouth to Market Street, Wilmington, Delaware.

After a complete review of all the relevant information, including comments and recommendations received in response to the above referenced public notice, we have decided to delete the above determined that existing Federal laws (Section 401 of the Rivers and Harbors Act, Section 402 of the Clean Water Act, the National Environmental Policy Act, Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, 33 CFR 210 et seq., 45 CFR 230 et seq.) adequately protect the navigational concerns for which the Harbor Lines were initially established. On balance, the deletion of these Harbor Lines is not contrary to the general public interest.
